

## Exam: The Strategic Dimension of Foreign Policy

### First Year Master's - Security and Strategic Studies

#### Question 01 :

Within the framework of the strategic dimension of foreign policy, which of the following options most accurately reflects the integrated use of foreign policy tools (diplomacy, economic aid or sanctions, alliances, information and media influence, and military force) to achieve a state's national goals?

- A) A state's direct use of military force when diplomacy fails, without considering the impact of economic sanctions or international public opinion.
- B) The use of diplomacy and alliances as tools separate from military power, while excluding information and media influence due to their perceived lack of strategic effectiveness.
- C) The simultaneous and flexible employment of foreign policy tools, where diplomacy and information/media influence are used to shape the international environment, economic sanctions and alliances are employed for indirect pressure, and military force is retained as a last-resort deterrent option.
